

## Reserves, National Guard and Other Military Services



There are policies to support entry into the Reserves or National Guard, or other military structures, as a civilian employee. The Reserves are organized on a voluntary basis. Reservists' contracts cannot be terminated by their employer solely because of interference between their civilian job and the Reservists' obligations when called to active

## **Enlistment Requirements**



Enlistment requirements for the physical fitness tests are different for men and women for those who apply for military college, military university and military academy. They are described in the Armed Forces' Unified Test laid out in the Ministry of Defence's 2010 Order. Requirements differ according to age. The different physiological characteristics of men and women are taken into consideration in strength, speed and physical resistance tests.




## **BULGARIA Retention Policies**



The Bulgarian Armed Forces have retention policies which consist of an additional monthly payment for confirmed or assigned class specialty; a salary increase and a rise in the minimum wage for military personne and the development of new regulations on a national level; career opportunities with a developed /career model; social benefits with additional leave days, free medical care, medical checks and recreation incentives depending on the number of years of service.
